



AUTOCROSS




Wednesday July 11th & Thursday July 12th
Autocross will be held in the parking lot of the Maverik Center

Autocross is the sport of trying to navigate a car through a defined course of pylons usually on a large parking lot, faster than your competition.

Events are run at speeds usually between 40-65 MPH, usually in 2nd gear. Autocross is a "performance driving event" and a safe way to learn how to drive at the car's limits. It is an event where people learn how to handle their Porsche at speeds that you drive daily
